Where: Rostraver Airport

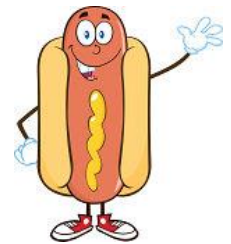
When: Sunday **August 19<sup>th</sup>**
