

Next General Membership Meeting, This Friday, May 19th, 6:30 PM, Chapter Hangar




Note that the time is earlier for grilling; we will start the grill probably around 6:00PM so plan to be early to have a burger or a hot dog.

Invented during WWII and offered later to various governments, this version was built for the United States in the early 1970's by Dornier. The inventor was Dr. Alexander Lippisch and he is known for not only inspiring tailless airplanes such as the WWII ME-163 rocket fighter, but also for brilliant understanding and teaching of aerodynamics. This Lippisch Aerodyne was somewhat unstable due to a small wing area and it relied on thrust for almost all control. In today's computer world, it would have been viable but jet power and helicopters were so highly developed by this time that the Navy lost interest. Lippisch died in 1976

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From Wiki: The **Stipa-Caproni**, also generally called the **Caproni Stipa**, was an experimental Italian aircraft designed in 1932 by Luigi Stipa (1900–1992) and built by Caproni. It featured a hollow, barrelshaped fuselage with the engine and propeller completely enclosed by the fuselage—in essence, the whole fuselage was a single ducted fan. Although the *Regia Aeronautica* (Italian Royal Air Force) was not interested in pursuing development of the Stipa-Caproni, its design was an important step in the development of jet propulsion.

In last month's newsletter, I asked "did any of these planes actually exist? If any of them did, who was the inventor? And did it actually get off the ground?

Paul Jencka was the only person to respond and he had two out of three guessed correctly. By the way, they all flew, and were all ducted fan thrust.





And the one Paul did not guess was the Coandă-1910, designed by Romanian inventor Henri Coandă, was an unconventional sesquiplane aircraft powered by a ducted fan. Called the "turbo-propulseur" by Coandă, its experimental engine consisted of a conventional piston engine driving a multibladed centrifugal blower which exhausted into a duct. Coandă claimed later that it flew a bit...
